D	Broccoli Breeding: mechanical harvesting and heat mitigation
E	Evaluate new insecticides/management strategies (conventional and organic) for insect pests
F	Conventional and organic controls of fungal diseases
2 A	Climatic adaptation (heat stress, cold stress)
B	Fusarium in snap beans
C	Market promotion of processed vegetables
D	VegNet; Expanding the Reach of Regional Insect Pest Monitoring
F	Farm Funding Programs; research, maintaining updated information on OPVC website, connection between available programs and the farmers
